What is CartoFront?

CartoFront is a FREE application that simplifies flood insurance for REALTORS®.

- On the buy side, agents can guide customers to houses that have the greatest potential of becoming *home*, while maintaining and growing their value.
- On the sell side, agents can proactively understand what questions may come up from potential buyers.

CartoFront's goal is to put you in a position to be a star ... and be the most knowledgeable, confident and profitable REALTOR® in your market.

How does CartoFront work?

In 'Three easy clicks' we take the guesswork out of flood insurance by providing you with an easy-to-use tool integrated into every listing.

- Go to any listing
- On the Display Bar, choose: *Agent Single Page
- On the bottom right of the listing, look for "the raindrop" on and click to request info

What is the cost to an Agent?

FREE. CartoFront is a value-added service as part of your Miami REALTORS® membership.

Is CartoFront bilingual?


Yes. At the top of the application, agents can choose English or Spanish. And help is here, if you need it - our Customer Success team is bilingual, too.

Do I need to install any software to use this program?

No. CartoFront is an online SaaS technology and integrated into the Matrix system. No download or install is required and CartoFront can be accessed from anywhere the agent can access Matrix, via an internet connection for both desktop and mobile.



What information is presented once I click on 'the raindrop'?



- Property image
- · Quick property info under the image
- Vertical display of quotes, with the lowest price first
- 3 share options on the left
 - PDF download
 - Copy link
 - Email to customer

How are estimated flood quotes determined'?

Working with our partner National General Insurance, a subsidiary of Allstate Insurance, we have taken a conservative approach to setting the flood quote parameters.

For the Government Quote (National Flood Insurance Program - NFIP):

- NFIP Standard Criteria: \$250,000 for building, \$100,000 for contents, \$2,500 deductible
- National General provides a validated flood zone determination (Zone X, AE, AH, VE)
- If customer proceeds to bind insurance, an Elevation Certificate may be required



For the Private Quotes (National General Product - Beyond Floods):

- Essential Criteria: \$250,000 for building, \$100,000 for contents, \$3,000 deductible
- Enhanced Criteria: \$300,000 for building, \$100,000 for contents, \$3,000 deductible
- National General quotes insurance based on individual property parcel
- National General quotes also include 'Loss of Use' and 'Other Buildings' Coverage
- National General private insurance goes up to \$1,500,000 for building
- Essential estimated price meant to provide 'apples to apples' cost comparison to NFIP

- Print PDF
- Copy link

How do I email information to my customer?

Simply add your customer email under our 'Share this quote with a client' section. You are welcome to use the sample message or customize your message to your customer. You can choose to copy yourself. Then click send!

On the receiving end, the customer receives an email from quotes@cartofront.com with the subject line: Flood Insurance Options - 1234 Property Address Drive (customize for the actual property address requested)

Beyond my customer, who else receives the email?

All customer emails are copied to the local insurance agent from GetAQuote.com, Insurance through MPX Insurance Services, Inc., Florida License # L104424. As part of the free service, CartoFront has partnered with a bilingual insurance agency to support, counsel, or bind flood insurance policies.

What's the best way to download or print the CartoFront information?

Click the 'Print a PDF' button, and the displayed information will be formatted into a PDF suitable for printing. All the information on the quote will be displayed on one page, and will be personalized to include the agent's name and email address. The agent would print out the PDF as they normally would any other printed material. The PDF will include the
