

America's Fastest Growing Cities




Welcoming almost 1,000 new residents every week, Miami is the 4th fastest growing city in the U.S. with 12% growth between 2012-2017.



Population Growth U.S. Census 2012-2017


America's Fastest Growing Job Markets



Miami leads the nation as the fastest growing job market with over 24% growth between 2012-2017.




UNEMPLOYMENT RATE










